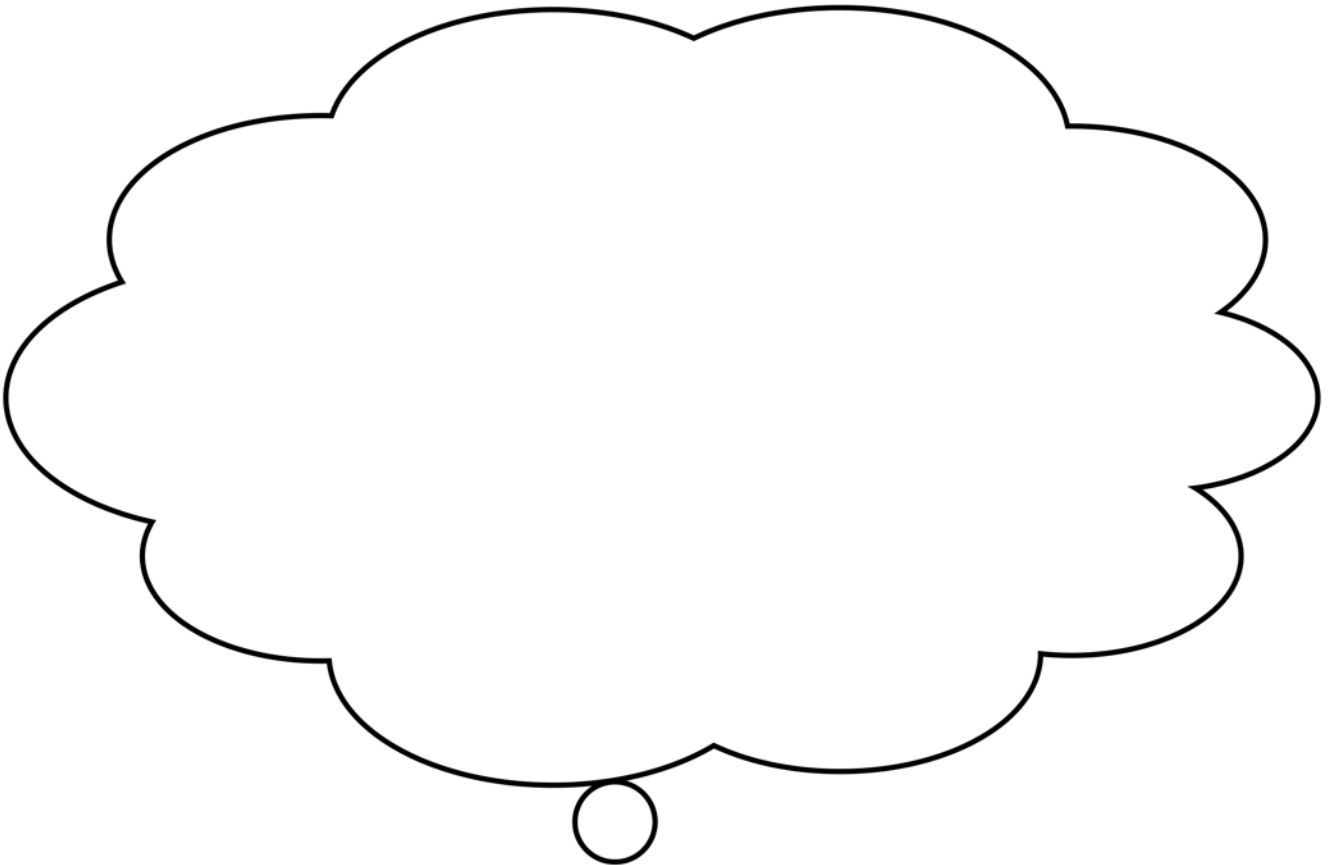
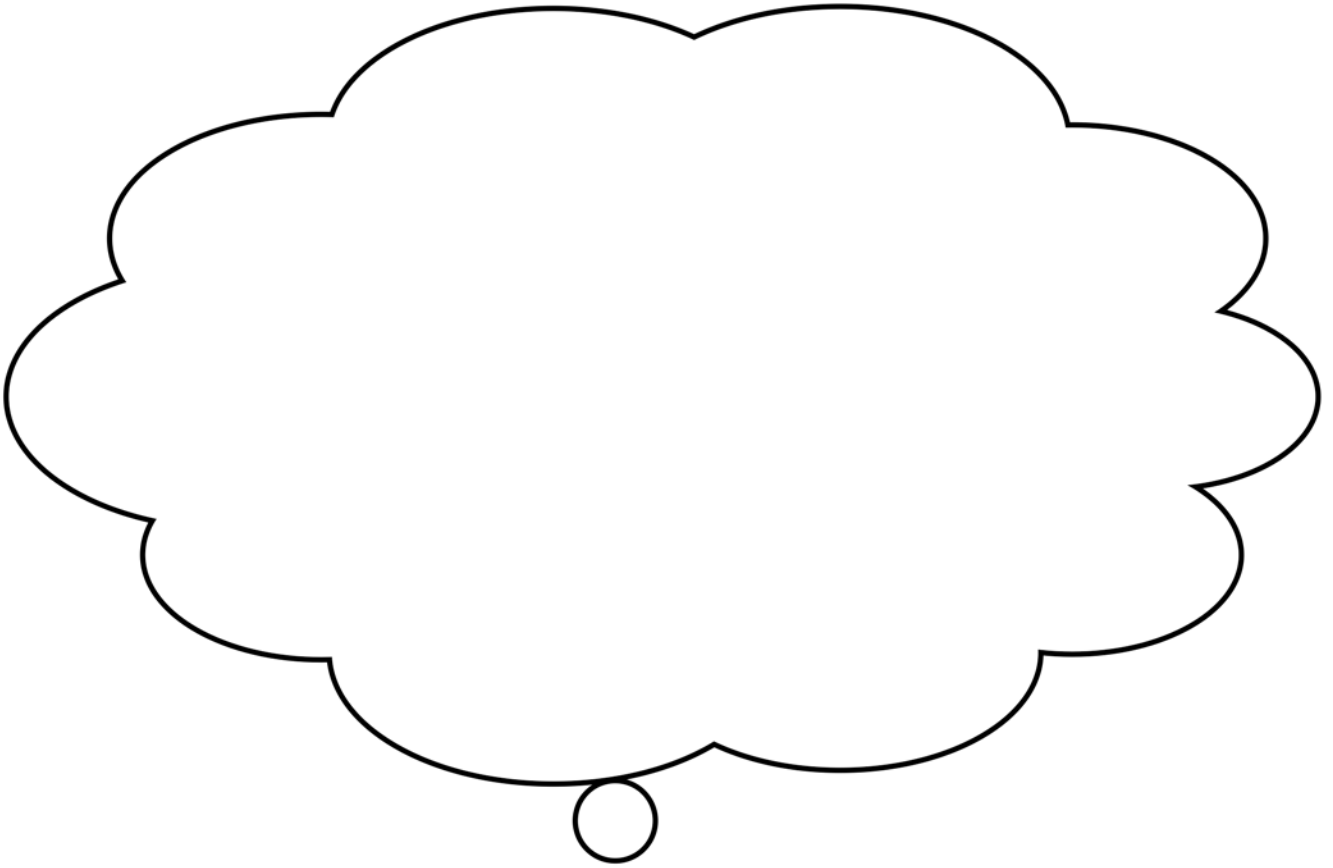

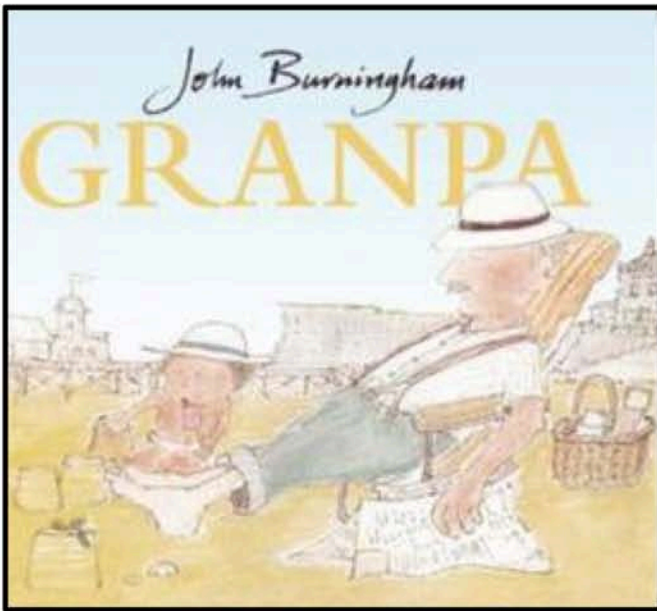

In this story, the night time changes the noises in the house, so that the boy in the story imagines that other things are happening. What do you imagine at night time?

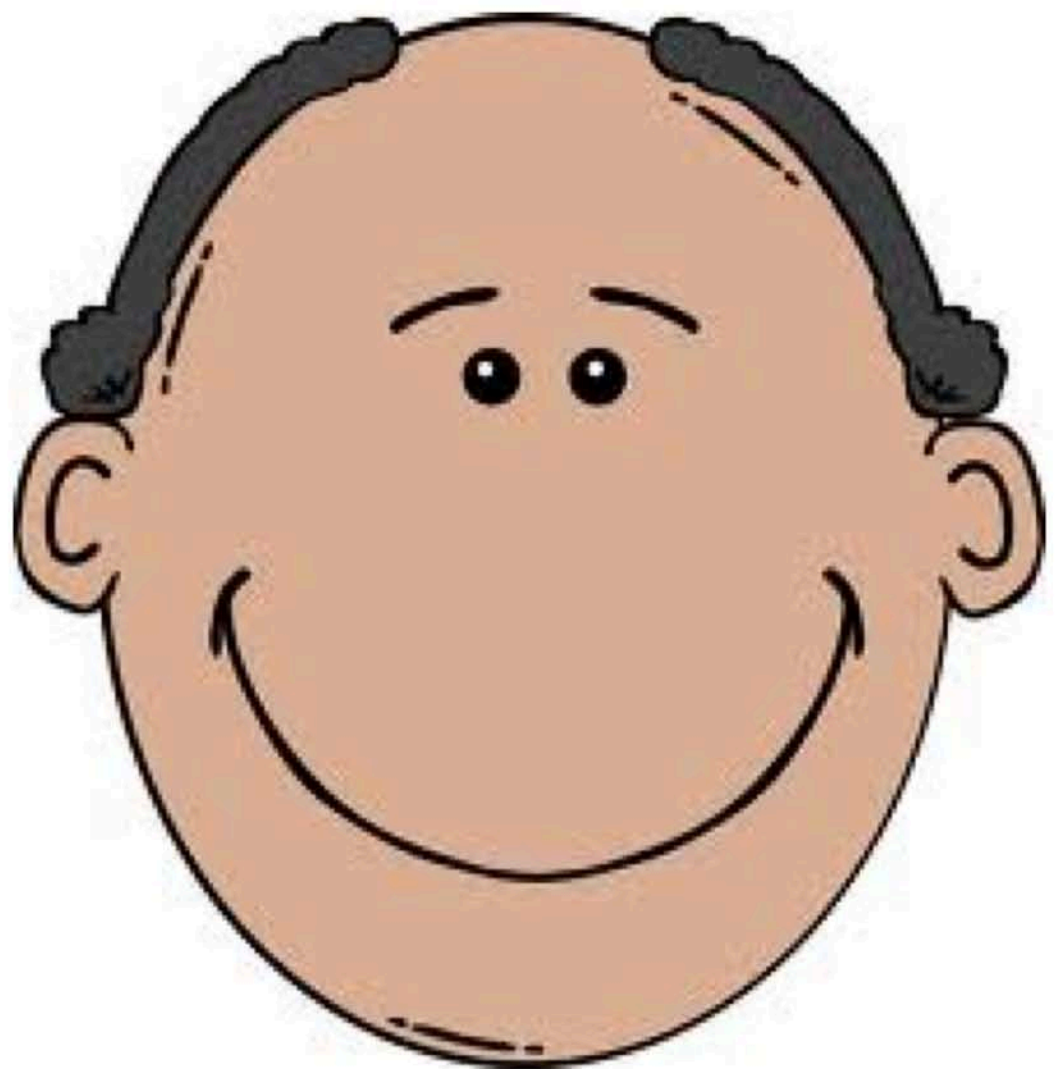

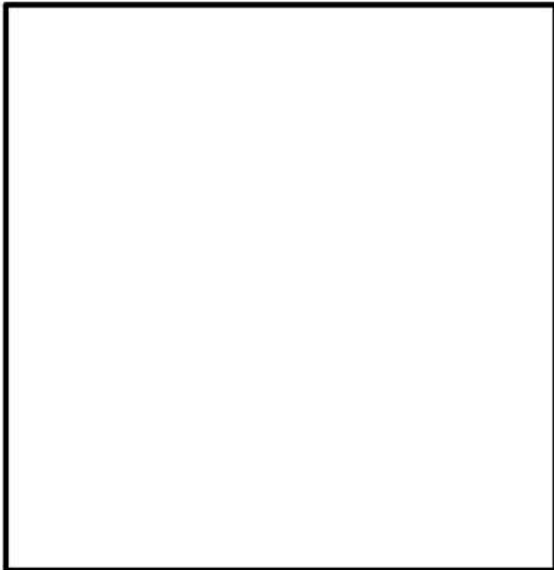

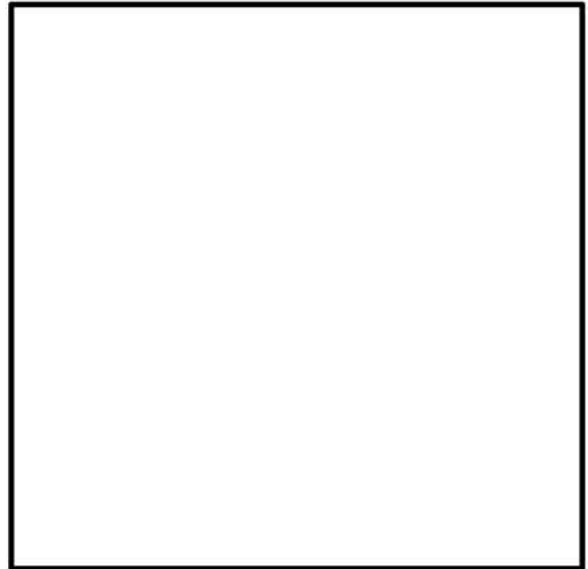
A Year On Our Farm

As the seasons change on the farm, the family have different jobs to do. Can you match the trees on the farm to the correct season?

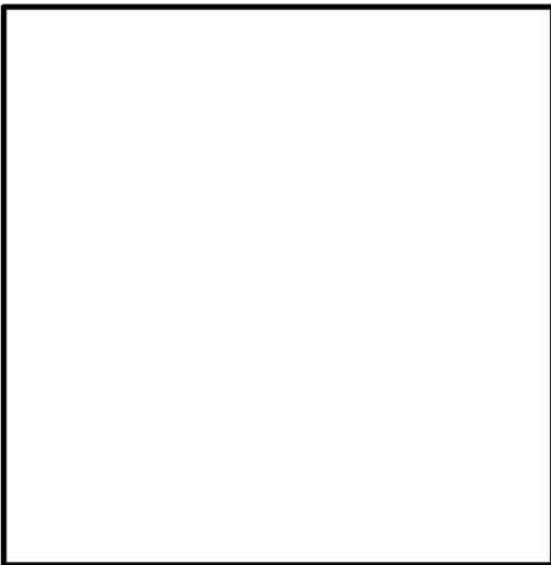

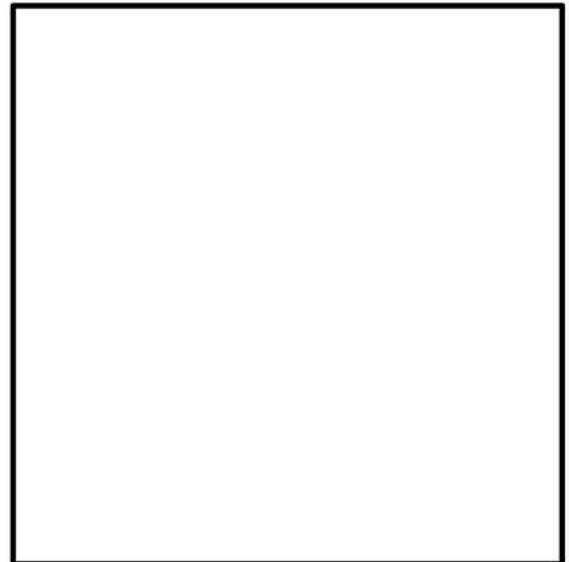
