Digging out

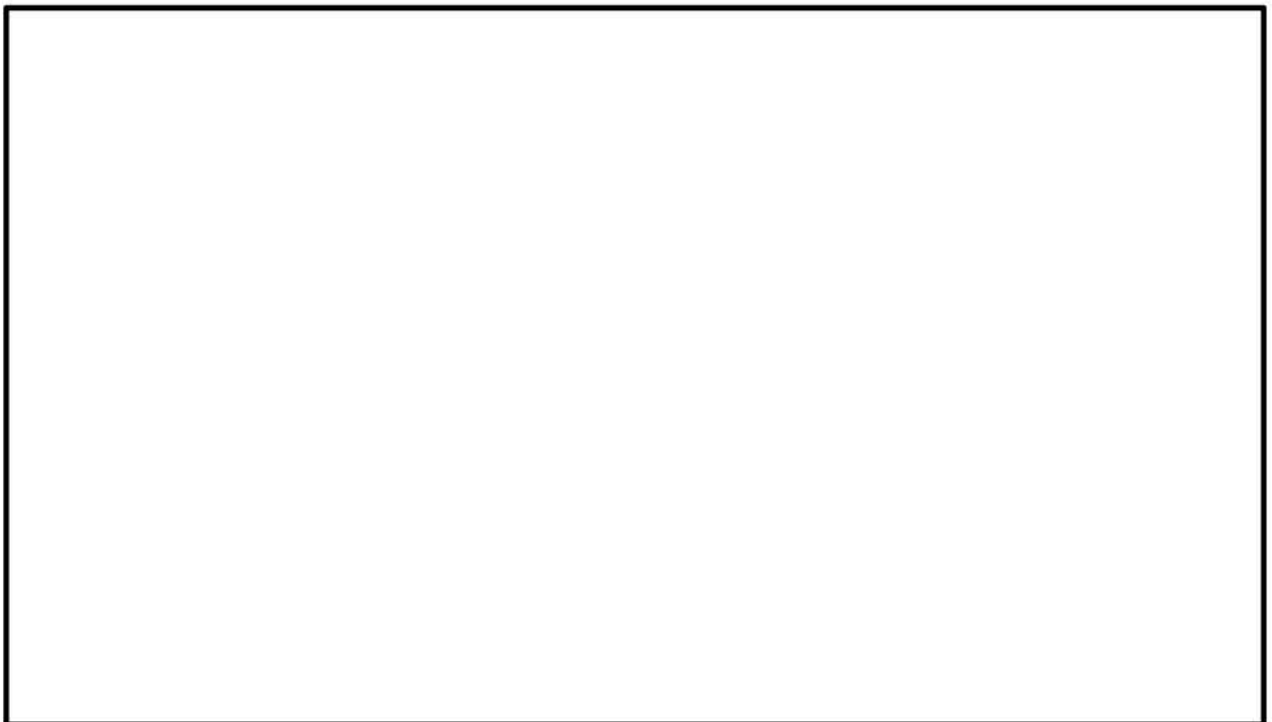

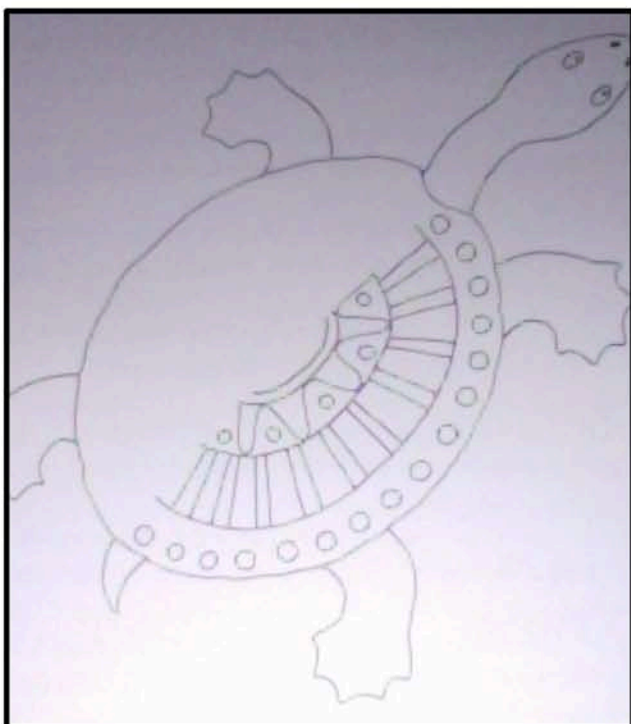
